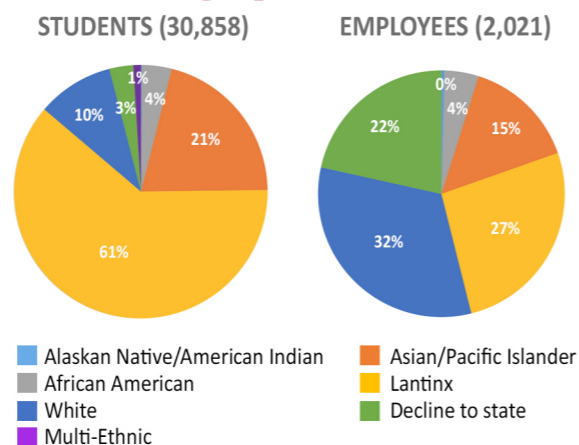
Our Equal Opportunity Commitment
